## How it Works

Assistance is provided in any setting  
chosen by the family, and is usually  
provided by both professionals and  
system representatives, and members  
of the adoptive family's community.  
Planning and coordination of services  
occurs in each family's team, comprised  
minimally of the parents, a facilitator,  
a family assistant and a parent partner.  
Some teams may be three or four  
people and others eight or ten.  
Children are usually team members  
depending on age.

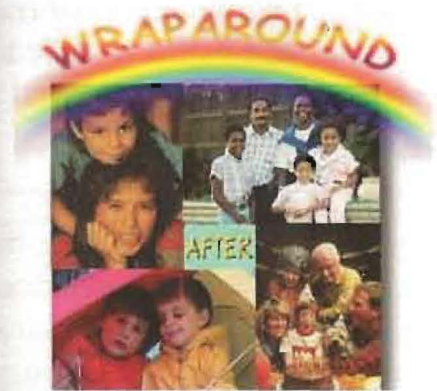

- engage supportive individuals in their constellation

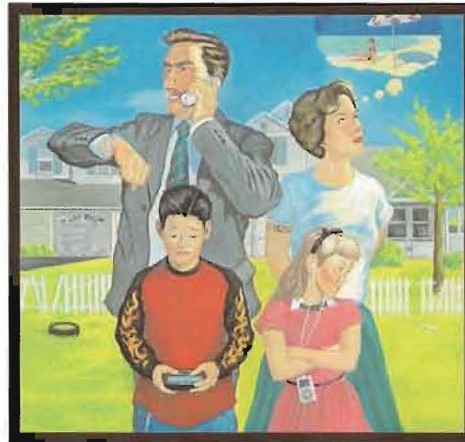
Adoption Wraparound is a collaboration among the family, the community, the County, and Kinship Center. The goal is to guide and encourage adoptive families in their unique journey in order to further their commitment to one another.

## WHERE WE CAN GO

With offices in San Jose, Salinas, Templeton and Santa Ana, we have the ability to work with families throughout California. We have served families from Crescent City to San Diego.

Counties we have partnered with to provide out-of-county Wraparound services include San Francisco, Shasta, Humboldt, Lake, Orange, Kern, San Luis Obispo, Sonoma, Ventura, San Mateo, Monterey, and Santa Clara.

Kinship Center offers expertise in both Adoption and Wraparound. We have been providing out-of-county Wraparound for nine years. We use technology extensively to enhance Family Teamwork, and do the research necessary to connect families to useful resources in their communities.



## HOW DO WE SET IT UP?

Because Wraparound mimics a formal placement, enrollment of a child involves relatively simple paperwork. Counties can engage Kinship Center through either:

- The family's completion of our participation forms, or
- An MOU or contract for one or more families, or
- An existing Wraparound provider as the conduit to fund our services
